**Grammar Cards For Week 4**

Number	Front	Back
68	Formation of present subjunctive active	Change the stem vowel according to the following pattern and add the personal signs for each conjugation. 1st a to e 2nd e to ea 3rd i or e to a 4th i to ia
69	Mood of purpose clauses	The main clause is active while the subordinate clause is subjunctive
70	Formation of imperfect active subjunctive	In all conjugations, add the regular final personal sign to the infinitive
