16	Predicate Nominative Case	Nominative
17	Position of <i>sum</i>	Anywhere In Sentence
19	Natural Gender Rule (applies to all declensions)	Nouns naming Male persons are masculine (<i>rex</i>), nouns naming female persons are feminine (<i>mater</i>).
20	Feminine Endings for 3rd Decl. only	SOX
21	Masculine Endings for 3rd Decl. only	ERROR
22	Neuter Endings for 3rd Decl. only	LANCET
32	The Two Groups of Adjectives	1. 1st/2nd Declension 2. 3rd Declension
33	Adjective/noun agreement	Adjectives agree with the nouns they modify in case, gender, and number but not necessarily declension
34	Position rules for adjectives	Adjectives of <i>quantity</i> precede their nouns, while adjectives of <i>quality</i> usually follow their nouns
35	Predicate adjective case	Nominative
61	Agreement of possessive adjectives	Possessive adjectives agree with the nouns they modify in case, gender, and number
