Number	Front	Back
19	Natural Gender Rule	Applies to all genders: A noun naming a male person is masculine A noun indicating a female person is feminine
20	Feminine endings rule for 3rd Declension	SOX
21	Masculine endings rule for 3rd Declension	ERROR
22	Neuter endings rule for 3rd Declension	LANCET
23	Appositive	A noun or phrase that is "put beside" another noun or phrase to rename it or explain it and is set off by commas
24	Agreement rule for appositives	An appositive agrees with its noun in case and number
