Number	Front	Back
26	Genitive Singular of 4th Declension Nouns	<i>-us</i>
27	Gender of 4th Declension Nouns	usually masculine
28	<i>in</i> with accusative <i>in</i> with ablative	<i>in</i> with accusative = motion <i>in</i> with ablative = rest
29	Preposition <i>in</i> with accusative and ablative	<i>in</i> with the accusative indicates motion <i>in</i> with the ablative indicates rest
30	Genitive singular ending of 5th declension nouns	<i>ei</i>
31	Gender of 5th declension nouns	usually feminine
