Number	Front	Back
5	Direct Object Case	Accusative
6	Position of Verb	Usually At The End Of The Sentence
7	Position of Adverb	Usually Right Before The Word It Modifies
8	Case for Possession and "Of"	Genitive
9	Genitive Singular Ending Of Second Declension Nouns	<i>-i</i>
10	Gender of Second Declension Nouns	<i>-us</i> = masculine; <i>-um</i> = neuter
11	Unique Characteristic of All 2nd Declension Nouns	Nominative and Accusative are the same in singular and plural
