8	Case for Possession and "Of"	Genitive
9	Genitive Singular Ending Of Second Declension Nouns	-i
10	Gender of Second Declension Nouns	-us = masculine; -um = neuter
11	Unique Characteristic of All 2nd Declension Nouns	Nominative and Accusative are the same in singular and plural
